#### EXTENSION TO EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

This is an extension ("Extension") to the Employment Agreement ("Agreement") between Greenwood Township ("Township") and Tina Tina Wright ("You") (collectively, the "Parties") dated June 1, 2017, an extension/addenda dated May 1, 2019 and an extension/addenda dated June 1, 2021.

To this end. The parties herby mutually agree to extend the Agreement, as follows:

#### 1) ARTICLE 2 – Term and Termination

<u>Term</u>: The term of the Employment Agreement will extend an additional two (2) years and remain in effect until May 31, 2027

All remaining provisions of ARTICLE 2 shall remain unchanged.

All other provisions of the Employee Agreement of June 1, 2017, the amendment of June 1, 2019 and the amendment dated June 1, 2021 shall remain unchanged.

**Effective Date:** The forgoing amendments to the Employment Agreement shall be retroactive from June 1, 2025, having been approved by the Township Board at their Meeting held on July 9, 2025.
