



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF
GARBAGE AND RUBBISH SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS (AND ROLL)**

**TO: AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS IN GREENWOOD TOWNSHIP, CLARE COUNTY,
MICHIGAN, AND ANY OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS:**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Greenwood Township Board will, pursuant to MCL 41.724(4) and special assessment formation documents, hold a public hearing at the Greenwood Township Hall, 3447 W. Temple Dr., Harrison, MI 48625 at 10:30 a.m. on May 30, 2026 to consider modifications in costs and imposed special assessments associated with the collection and disposal of garbage and rubbish (including any access to recycling), which are specially assessed on benefitting properties according to apportionments and a special assessment district (currently consisting of residential improved properties) by the Township Board. Such hearing shall also consider whether to modify the special assessment district by adding additional benefitting properties (e.g., improved commercial properties). Documents related to the special assessment district including a proposed special assessment roll, list of parcels to be included in the special assessment district, and estimates of costs are available for inspection upon request to the Township Clerk listed below.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the owner or any person having an interest in property within the special assessment district above may, if authorized, file a written appeal with the Michigan Tax Tribunal within thirty (30) days after confirmation of the special assessment roll. Appearance and protest at the public hearing on the special assessment roll are required to appeal the special assessment to the Michigan Tax Tribunal. An owner or other party of interest or his or her agent may, if authorized, (1) appear in person at any hearing to protest the special assessment, or (2) file his or her appearance or protest by letter before the close of the hearing using the address below.

The Township Board shall maintain a record of parties who appear to protest at the special assessment hearing. If the hearing is terminated or adjourned for the day before a party is provided the opportunity to be heard, a party whose appearance was recorded shall be considered to have protested the special assessment in person. Greenwood Township will make accommodations for individuals with disabilities. Persons needing accommodation should contact the Township not less than four (4) days before the public hearing using the number below. Annual redeterminations of the special assessments above will occur annually with mailing notice being provided for increases over 10%. Such necessary redeterminations of costs may be made without further notice to record owners or parties of interest in properties. See MCL 41.724(2).
